## ACCEPTED ITEMS

## REMEMBER THE CORE 4:

- Clean glass bottles and jars
- Clean metal cans
- Clean plastic bottles and jugs
- Clean paper and cardboard

These items include:

- Cereal \& cracker boxes (remove liner)
- Frozen dinner boxes
- Paper milk \& juice cartons
- Paper towel cores
- Styrofoam ${ }^{\circledR}$ egg cartons
- Yogurt \& butter tubs
- Ad circulars
- Catalogs
- Copy \& printer paper
- Envelopes
- File folders
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Paperback books
- Phone books
- Plastic spray bottles (remove nozzle)
- Shampoo \& lotion bottles
- Toilet paper tubes
- Toothpaste boxes (not the tubes)


## PLASTIC BAGS

Plastic shopping bags need special attention. Bunch dry, clean shopping bags together until you have a bundle about the size of a soccer ball. Put that entire bundle inside of ONE plastic shopping bag, tie it then toss it into the blue cart. No black bags please.

Besides your plastic shopping bags (bundled together as above), you can also recycle:

- Retail bags
(hard plastic and string handles removed)
- Paper towel and toilet paper plastic wrapping
- Newspaper bags
- Dry-cleaning bags
- Bread bags
- Produce bags
- Furniture/electronic wrap

LOOSE PLASTIC BAGS ARE NEVER ACCEPTED.

## NON-ACCEPTED ITEMS

- Loose plastic bags
- Household trash
- Aluminum foil
- Appliances
- Auto glass
- Clothes \& clothes hangers
- Computer cords
- Diapers - baby and adult
- Dead animals
- Garden hoses
- Hardcover books
- Light bulbs
- Toys
- Hard plastic or large plastic
- Hazardous materials
- Electronic materials
- Shredded paper
- Styrofoam ${ }^{\circledR}$ formed packing or "peanuts"
- Trash bags
- Waxed paper and waxed food containers
- Yard trimmings
- Organic materials such as food scraps
